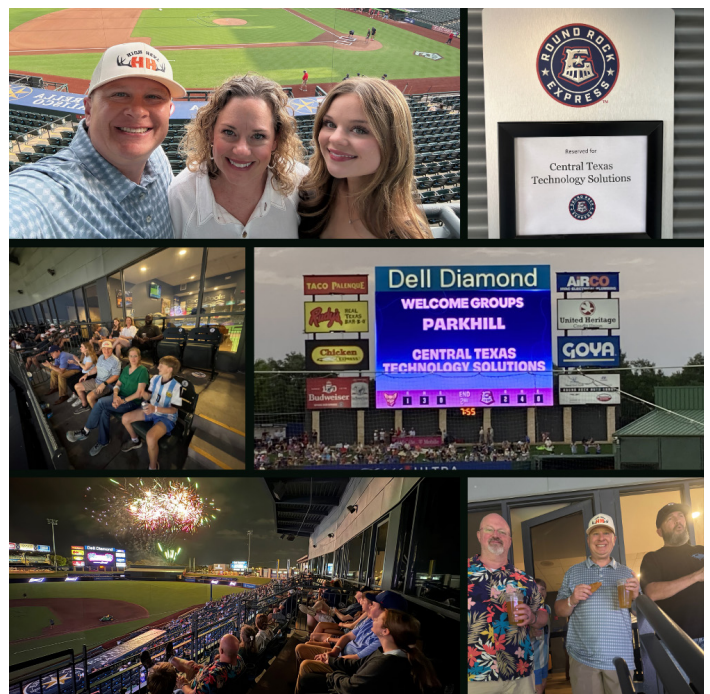
Over time, this leads to lost productivity, unnecessary costs, and more complexity than your business should have to manage.
